Make these cute chicks from an egg carton and some paper as a beak. You could look in your garden for feathers to decorate your chicks

Glue cotton balls or scrunched up paper to card to make a bunny. You could colour the ears and nose instead of coloured paper



### Hand Print Flowers

Draw round and colour, cut and stick or paint your hands to make colourful bouquets.



### Nature Collage

Use leaves and twigs to make a seasonal collage



### Easter Baking

You could make and decorate some themed cupcakes.



### Miniature Garden

Use things from your garden or home to create a miniature garden
